

Finished Project Size: 12" (30.48cm) diameter



## Supplies Needed

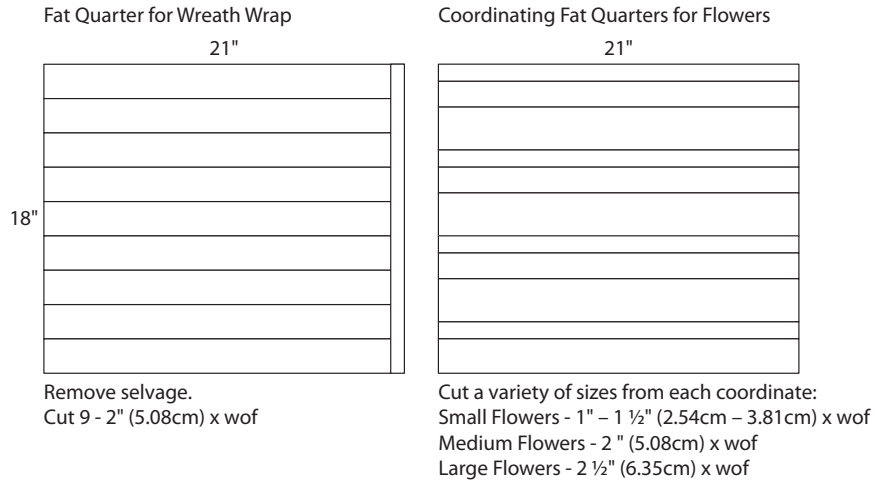
- 5 - Fat quarters (18" x 21") WMFQ20 – Patriotic
- Craft or low temp glue gun
- 12" (30.48cm) Foam wreath
- Iron, pressing surface
- Sewing machine (optional)
- White felt (optional)
- Medium blue embroidery floss (optional)

## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not prewash fabrics. Before cutting, press fat quarters with a dry iron on cotton setting. **Note:** Do not press felt. Print instructions at 100% scale and check measurement of leaf template after printing to ensure correct print size. Width of fabric = wof

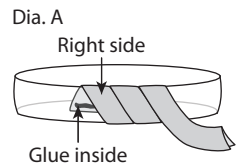
# Cutting

Remove the selvage edge from the short end of one fat quarter. For wrapping the wreath, cut the fat quarter into 2" (5.08) strips along the width of fabric, approx. 21" (53.34cm). For twisted flowers, cut the coordinating fat quarters into strips of varying sizes 1" (2.54cm) to 2 1/2" (6.35cm) along the width of fabric.



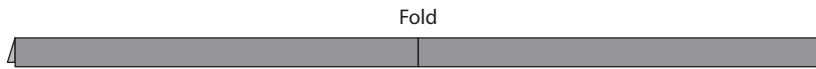
## Fabric Covered Wreath

1. Sew or glue 2" (5.08cm) strips together end to end to make one long fabric strip. Leave one 2" (5.08cm) strip to use as a hanging loop at the end.
2. Wrap strips around wreath form, starting and ending with glue to secure (Diagram A).

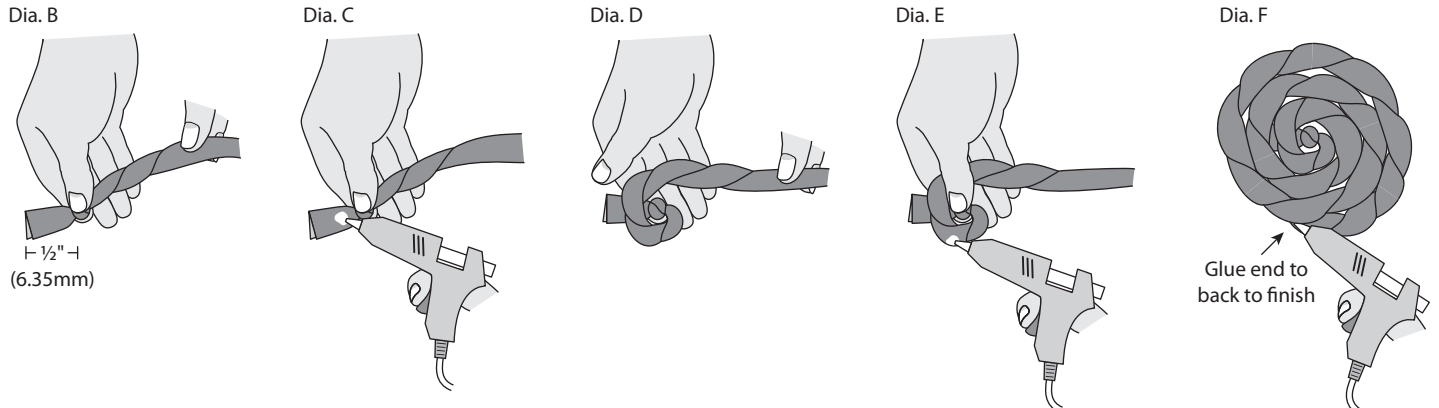


## Twisted Rose Flowers

1. For each large flower, sew or glue two 2 1/2" (6.35cm) strips together end to end to make longer strips. For each small or medium flower, use one or two strips.
2. Fold strips in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together and press.

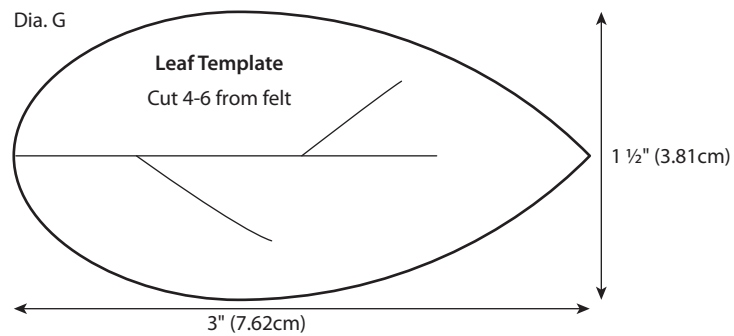


3. Make a knot 1/2" (1.27cm) from one end. Hold the knot in one hand with your thumb and use your other hand to twist the loose end of the strip (Dia. B).
4. Carefully apply a small dot of glue (Dia. C) and wrap the twisted end around the knot (Dia. D).
5. Continue twisting and wrapping the strip around the knot, alternating gluing as needed (Dia. E).
6. To finish, bring the end to the back of the flower and glue in place (Dia. F).



### Felt Leaves: (optional)

- Using template, cut 2-3 leaves from white felt. If desired, layer two leaves and embroider veins in blue.



## Finishing

- Arrange large, medium and small roses on the wreath, using straight pins to secure temporarily as you find the best placement. Place leaves, if using, to fill in spaces. When arrangement is final, glue roses and leaves in place securely.



- Create hanging loop from 2" x 12" (5.08cm x 30.48cm) strip of fabric and sew or knot the ends.

## Finished Care Instructions

Keep out of bright direct sunlight. Dust as needed.
